

Please provide an update of the Northern Virginia Electric Cooperative's interest in co-locating a delivery point within the proposed Haymarket Substation. Please provide the status of any plans by any entity other than the Company to locate a delivery point within or near the proposed Haymarket Substation.

Response:

Northern Virginia Electric Cooperative ("NOVEC") continues to express interest in a new delivery point in the Haymarket area; however, the location, timing, and size has not been determined and will depend on the continued development in NOVEC's territory along the Route 15 corridor, south of Haymarket, and the Route 55 corridor, west of Haymarket.

It should be noted that NOVEC's service territory (depicted by the purple-shaded area below), along the Route 15 corridor south of Haymarket, is sourced from their Broad Run Substation in Fauquier County and includes an approximately 140 acre rezoning request for Woodbourne Preserve (REZ2015-20003), east of Route 15, west of Old Carolina Road, and south of Thoroughfare Road, to allow for the development of 107 single-family detached dwelling units. This is in addition to the approximately 350 residential units remaining in the Villages of Piedmont (according to Prince William County's 2015 Build-Out Analysis, which is the latest available from the County website), located west of Route 15, just south of the proposed Haymarket Substation.
